## NO. 16 OF 1994: APPROPRIATION ACT, 1994.

It is hereby notified that the President has assented to the following Act, which is hereby published for general information:

## ACT

To appropriate amounts of money for the requirements of the State during the financial year ending 31 March 1995.

(Afrikaans text signed by the President.) (Assented to 16 November 1994.)

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa, as follows:-

**Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of State, excluding former provinces, former Republics of Transkei, Bophuthatswana, Venda and Ciskei and former self-governing territories**

1. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the State, excluding the former provinces, the former Republics of Transkei, Bophuthatswana, Venda and Ciskei, and the former self-governing territories, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the State Revenue Account, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of Schedule 1.

**Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of area of former province of Cape of Good Hope**

2. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former province of the Cape of Good Hope, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Account for Provincial Services: Cape, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of Schedule 2.

**Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of area of former province of Natal**

3. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former province of Natal, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Account for Provincial Services: Natal, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of Schedule 3.

**Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of area of former province of Orange Free State**

4. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former province of the Orange Free State, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Account for Provincial Services: Orange Free State, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of Schedule 4.

**Appropriation of amounts of money for requirements of area of former province of Transvaal**

5. Subject to the provisions of the Exchequer Act, 1975 (Act No. 66 of 1975), there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former province of the Transvaal, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Account for Provincial Services: Transvaal, the amounts of money shown in column 1 of Schedule 5.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former Republic of Transkei**

6. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Transkei Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former Republic of Transkei, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Transkei Revenue Account, the amount of R6 253 854 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former Republic of Bophuthatswana**

7. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Bophuthatswana Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former Republic of Bophuthatswana, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Bophuthatswana Revenue Account, the amount of R4 786 510 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former Republic of Venda**

8. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Venda Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former Republic of Venda, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Venda Revenue Account, the amount of R1 846 548 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former Republic of Ciskei**

9. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Ciskei Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former Republic of Ciskei, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Ciskei Revenue Account, the amount of R2 699 227 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of Gazankulu**

10. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Gazankulu Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of Gazankulu, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Gazankulu Revenue Account, the amount of R1 780 276 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of KaNgwane**

11. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the KaNgwane Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of KaNgwane, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the KaNgwane Revenue Account, the amount of R1 096 114 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of KwaNdebele**

12. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the KwaNdebele Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of KwaNdebele, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the KwaNdebele Revenue Account, the amount of R807 406 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of KwaZulu**

13. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the KwaZulu Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of KwaZulu, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the KwaZulu Revenue Account, the amount of R7 081 756 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of Lebowa**

14. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Lebowa Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of Lebowa, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Lebowa Revenue Account, the amount of R4 223 366 000.

**Appropriation of amount of money for requirements of area of former self governing territory of Qwaqwa**

15. Subject to the provisions of any law governing the application and withdrawal of moneys from the Qwaqwa Revenue Fund, there are hereby appropriated out of the National Revenue Fund for the requirements of the area of the former self-governing territory of Qwaqwa, during the financial year ending 31 March 1995, as a charge to the Qwaqwa Revenue Account, the amount of R959 375 000.

**Short title**

16. This Act shall be called the *Appropriation Act, 1994*.
