HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT NO.56 OF 1974)**REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE SPECIALITIES AND SUBSPECIALITIES IN
MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY: AMENDMENT**

The Minister of Health, under section 61(1)(f) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974), and after consultation with the Health Professions Council of South Africa, intend to make the regulations in the Schedule.

Interested persons are hereby invited to submit written comments or representations on this proposed Notice to the Director-General: Health, Private Bag X828, Pretoria, 0001 (for attention of the Director: Public Entities Governance), within three months of the date of publication of this Notice.

SCHEDULE**Definitions**

1. In these regulations “**the Regulations**” means the Regulations relating to the Specialities and Subspecialities in Medicine and Dentistry published under Government Notice No. R. 590 of 29 June 2001, as amended by Government Notices Nos. R. 1457 of 13 December 2004, R. 712 of 17 August 2007, and R. 645 of 22 August 2012, and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Regulations shall bear such meaning, unless the context indicates otherwise.

Amendment of regulation 4 of the Regulations

2. Regulation 4 of the Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion, in alphabetical order, of the following registrable subspecialties and basic specialities:
