Spreadsheet Format

Since August 2017, project information is regularly updated onto a Project in Progress Spreadsheet in Excel format, which can be downloaded only by subscribers to the *Research Channel Africa*.


Search

A search facility enables the execution of structured database searches of published material. The facility allows users to **find articles, project information, mine profiles or research reports using words, phrases and timeframes**. Users can also **save up to 50 searches** for future reference. The search criteria for saved searches is stored in memory allowing the inclusion of previously and newly published content if saved searches are repeated.




Mine Profiles
